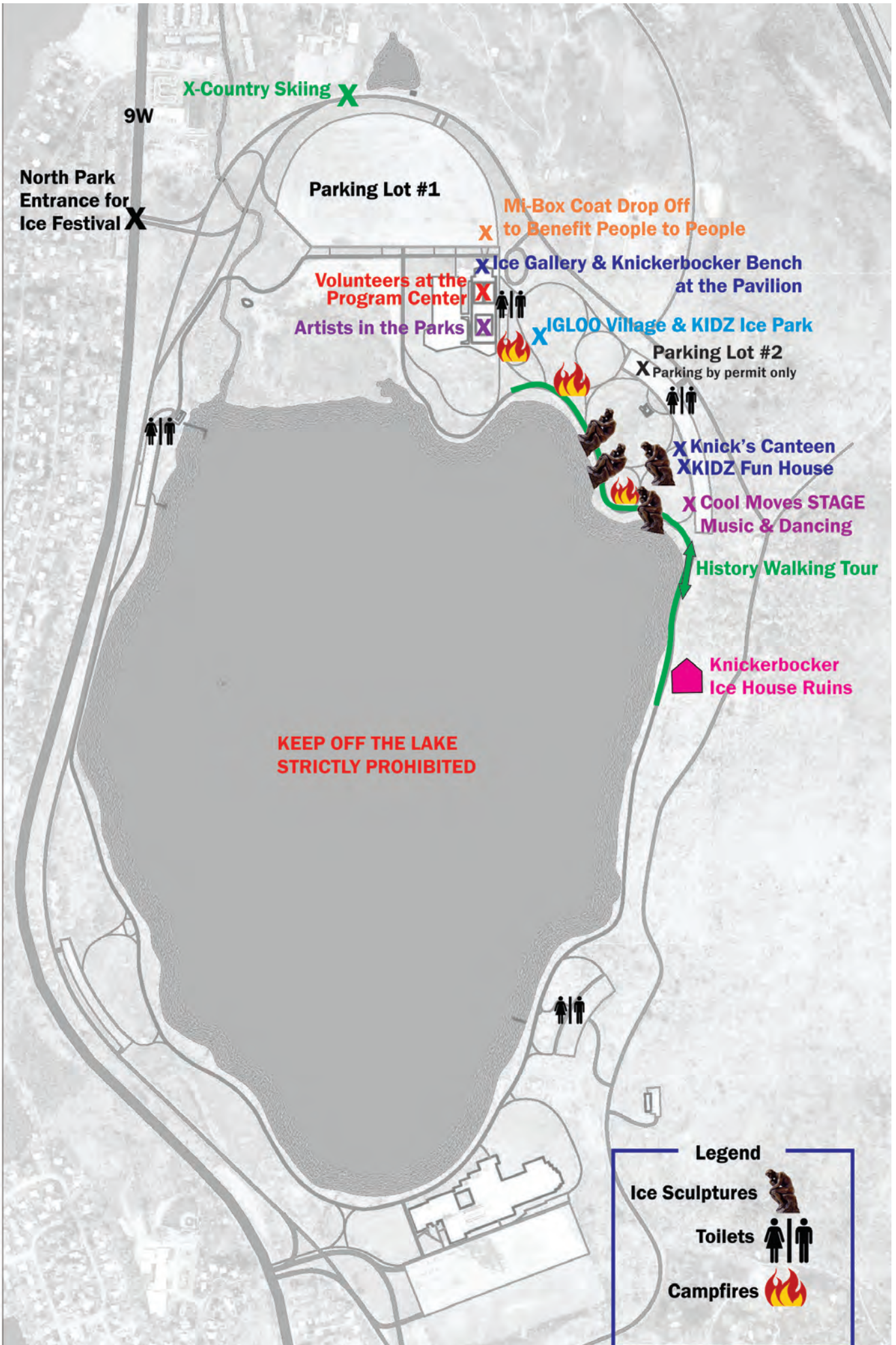
**Cross Country Skiing:** Weather permitting. Across from Parking Lot #1
